Entry Requirements

- 1. Age Requirement: Students must be 11 years old or above to participate in the programme.
- 2. Dance or Theatre Experience: While prior dance or theatre experience is preferred, it is not mandatory. However, you should be willing to learn and develop your skills in these areas and must attend classes at Colman Creative Academy.
- 3.Commitment: Student helpers must be committed to attending all assigned classes and completing the required theory work and must give a minimum of 1 months notice, should they wish to leave the programme.
- 4. Professionalism: Student helpers must demonstrate a high level of professionalism and responsibility at all times, including adhering to dress codes and punctuality. You should be willing to present yourself in a professional manner and take responsibility for your actions.
- 5. Communication: Student helpers must possess excellent communication skills, including the ability to communicate effectively with instructors, students, and parents. You should be willing to work on improving your communication skills and be open to feedback.
- 6.Leadership: Student helpers must have strong leadership skills and be able to take initiative and lead by example. You should be willing to develop your leadership skills and take on leadership roles within the programme.
